Dear Parents and Carers,

As you would have heard over the holidays, all Primary School students will be returning to school next Monday 12 October. What a long wait it has been to get to this stage.

Due to the late notice of the students in Grades 3 – 6 returning next week, we have had to make some changes to our Online Learning and Parent/Teacher Interviews.

Please read these carefully:

- From tomorrow, there will be **no** Online Learning in Google Classroom/Meet with teachers Prep to 6. This enables teachers to run Parent/Teacher Interviews throughout the week. The Grade 3 to 6 teachers will be informing you of the times for these meetings, which they are working on at this very moment.
- Prep to 2 times will remain as planned.
- If students have any questions for teachers, they can leave messages on stream and the teachers will reply when they are available.
- Students - please continue to do your work from their Learning Packs this week. Students' are to bring back their Learning Packs on their return to school on Monday.
- There are still a number of Learning Packs at the front door of the school so if you have not yet picked up your pack, please do so ASAP.
- Thursday is a Planning Day for all staff (Staff will not be available).
- Friday is Professional Practice Day for the 5/6 Unit (5/6 Staff will not be available).

When students return to school next Monday, students are to be dropped off at the gates and parents are to stay outside the fence making sure they follow social distancing please. Our gates on Cresser Street, Fifth Ave and Seventh Ave will be open until 9:00am. This is the same as last return to school.

Staff will be at the gates to greet the students and show them to their line up area, as some of these have changed due to our building works.

The Prep students will be excited to see their new rooms. They will now be in rooms 1 and 2, which have been renovated and are looking very special. We also have brand new toilets for the students' and many repairs have been done to the roof, windows, downpipes and offices. The next stage is the start of our new building which will commence in a few weeks time.
