
There has been lots of great learning happening this week with our celebrations for Education Week so don't forget to have a chat with your children about what they are learning.

Staying COVID Safe: Please continue to follow our protocols to keep the students, staff, families and community safe.

- At this stage we are not allowing parents/guardians to enter the school building, unless parent/guardian is making a payment or has an appointment. We will keep you updated when this changes.
