Dear Families,

Staff at Altona North Primary School have been working hard to set up remote and flexible learning for every child.

We understand that many families may feel unsure or apprehensive about the remote and flexible learning, so it is our aim to make it as stress free as possible for everyone.

For the first two weeks of the term, students will be given hard copies of learning tasks in their learning package, accompanied with some educational sites they can explore if they are able.

Over these first two weeks, ANPS staff will be working towards enabling all families to access online learning. Teachers will be setting up Google Classroom and this will be used in conjunction with take home learning packages.

Further advice will be sent home soon via our webpage, Facebook and SMS messages.

We will continue to inform you and provide you with guidance. We wish to reassure you that we do not expect everything in the learning package to be completed. *We only ask that you do the best that you can do.*

There will be some learning tasks that teachers will ask to be completed, while other learning tasks are an option. *If your child is unable to do something, that's ok, just encourage them to do a different learning task.*

Help them by setting up a space for learning if possible, set routines and follow daily schedules set by teachers when you are able.

Remember, your child's emotional well-being is very important during this time so the best way to help your child is to provide encouragement, positive support and spend quality time with them. And try to have FUN.
